Dressage PEI (DPEI) is planning a series of Schooling shows in 2021. Entrants will ride a National test (see below). This is an opportunity for all riders to practise their tests in front of a judge to gain experience, and for riders of other disciplines to try dressage tests.

These competitions will be subject to COVID rules in effect at the time of the show. Rules regarding travel from out of province will also depend on restrictions at the time of the show.

If there is a change in the COVID-19 situation, Dressage PEI may find it necessary to cancel any or all shows planned.

The tests are developed by the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and the United States Dressage Federation (USDF).

The following tests will be offered and can be found on the EC website at www.equestrian.ca/sport/dressage/tests :

- Introductory Level Tests A, B and C
- Training Level Tests 1, 2 and 3
- First Level Tests 1, 2 and 3
- Second Level Tests 1, 2 and 3

Higher levels may be entered with permission of the Show Secretary.

Western Dressage tests may be offered if requested and space is available.

Equestrian Canada horse recordings, formal dressage showing attire (i.e., jackets, white breeches) and dressage tack not required; only a neat appearance is requested. **However, all riders MUST wear an approved helmet at all times when mounted, have safe tack and have an Island Horse Council (IHC) membership www.islandhorsecouncil.ca/membership-form or equivalent from other provinces.**

RULES AND CONDITIONS

Insurance

1. For insurance reasons, Island Horse Council membership (or equivalent from other provinces) is required.

Equestrian Canada memberships

2. Equestrian Canada Sport Licences and Horse Recordings are not required.

Entries

3. Completed entries are to be sent to the Competition Secretary **no later than a week before the show**. Entries may have to be limited. In this case, completed entries will be prioritized initially by Dressage PEI membership and subsequently by the earliest date received, first come first served. **Entries will be accepted for only one horse per rider.**
4. All entries must be accompanied by a cheque or money order made out to "Dressage PEI." Online e-transfers to show secretary will also be accepted, ***feproud23@bellaliant.net***.
5. No horse may be entered in more than two levels at the same competition and these levels must be consecutive.
6. The entry form for the competition shall be signed by the person responsible for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. A parent or guardian must sign the entry form if there is no other person responsible.

Refund Policy

7. All refunds are contingent upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate or a medical doctor's certificate. If the proper documentation is given to the Competition Secretary seven (7) days prior to the competition (the closing date for entries), all fees submitted to Dressage PEI will be refunded. Documentation received after the closing date for entries and less than five (5) days after the competition date entitle the applicant to an 80% refund of all entry fees submitted to Dressage PEI (excluding number and administration fees). Refunds will not be entertained if documentation has not been received before the fifth (5th) day after the competition unless extenuating circumstances prevail. In such cases, refunds must be approved by the current Dressage PEI executive. Refunds for circumstances other than illness of the competitor or horse will not be entertained.

Competition Guidelines

8. The show will recognize three categories of competitors:
 - a) Open (O) - All competitors (regardless of age and/or amateur/professional status)
 - b) Adult Amateur (AA) - All riders who are no longer Juniors under EC Rule E 3.4.3 (except as outlined in 3.4.2) individual Canadian competitors (see Amateur Status, Rule E 3.4.2). (The Amateur category is for athletes over the age of 18 who are not earning remuneration from teaching or training in the horse industry.)
 - c) Junior (J) - All riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of January 1, 2021.
9. Riders may wear smooth leather half chaps with paddock boots. They may wear a conservative coloured shirt with sleeves and riding breeches.

10. There will be no award ceremony or prizes presented. Ribbons will be given out with test sheets.
11. Lunging (mounted) is not permitted under penalty of elimination. Lunging will not be permitted in the warm-up ring if another rider is present. Riders are asked to pass left to left and to maintain a respectful (1.5 m) distance from other riders. The Show Committee will designate an area for lunging.
12. Entries will not be allowed to leave and return to the show grounds during the competition.

General

13. Stalls are available for arrival the afternoon before the show or morning of the show, \$30. Show Secretary will be available to accept horses between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. the day before the show.
14. The Kensington Veterinary Clinic will be on-call for emergencies during the competition.
15. The Competition Committee reserves the right to govern all conditions of the competition and its entries.
16. Crapaud Agriplex and Dressage PEI will not be held responsible for damage, injury or loss to persons, horses or property of exhibitors or spectators.
17. In the case of cancellation, competitors will be notified as soon as possible.
18. All tests will be ridden in 20 metres X 60 metres ring.
19. Competition numbers must be worn and visible in schooling rings and on the grounds, as well as in the competition ring.
20. To comply with our contract with the Crapaud Agriplex, a daily \$15 fee will be charged for overnight camping (tents or trailers). This fee applies both to trailers connected to power and/or water and those not connected.

RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be available on the Dressage PEI Facebook two days prior to the competition, after which times will be posted at the stable.

PRECAUTIONS DURING COVID-19:

1.

A Venue Access List will be prepared listing all the people expected to attend the show. This will include 1 competitor per horse along with 1 support person. No other person may enter the show ground, except volunteers listed on the Venue Access List

2. Shavings will be prepaid and delivered to stalls in advance.
3. Directional tape will be installed on the floor, and horses and riders will enter on one end of the barn and exit at the other end.
4. People will be instructed to stay on the side of the barn where their horse is stabled.
5. The number of horses in the warm-up rings at any one time will be limited.
6. Arrival and departures may be staggered to avoid contact between participants.
7. No spectators are allowed.

Responsibilities of Participants:

Reminder: Participants are attending the competition at their own risk. They are liable and must take personal responsibility for the safety of others and themselves. Participants must comply with all best practices and guidelines in effect at the competition.

- Complete required competition waivers, checklists and daily attestations.
- Do not share supplies, horse clothing, towels, equipment or tack (including lead shanks, etc.).
- Adhere to physical distancing guidelines.
- Wash and/or sanitize hands frequently.
- Adhere to cough and sneeze etiquette. Participants who begin to cough/sneeze for any reason should move away from others until coughing/sneezing dissipates.
- Non-medical masks are required to be worn at all times when not mounted.
- Leave the competition venue litter free.
- Leave the venue as soon as possible after their classes have concluded.
- If they become sick within two (2) weeks following a show, contact the show organizer and indicate the events and dates that they were onsite.

Prior to entering the show ground each day, every person will be required to sign and date a “*Daily COVID Attestation and Agreement*” (sample will be provided with ride times and stabling instructions).

INSURANCE DECLARATION

The attached “*Equine Waiver*” must be signed and returned with entry form or prior to the competition. Note that there are two pages: For participants Over the Age of Majority and For participants Under the Age of Majority. Please complete only the page which applies to the competitor. As per the Prince Edward Island *Age of Majority Act*, “Every person attains the age of majority and ceases to be a minor on attaining the age of eighteen years.”

Entries must be received no later than a week before the show, JUNE 11. No late entries will be accepted.
